- **Use large repeat 8/9”-24” for more variety**
 - **At least 3 colors**
 - **No straight lines**
- **Prefers 60 degree ruler with point, not blunt tip**
 - **Do not wash material**

She also demonstrated how to fold a quilt and suggested storing them in pillowcases, not plastic bags, to allow quilts to breathe.
