Date: Wednesday, Dec. 7, 2022

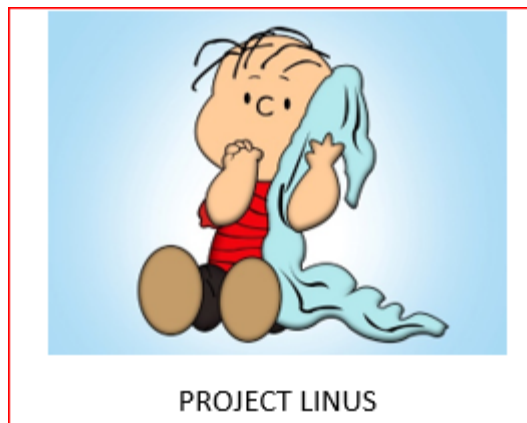
Time: 6:00 pm

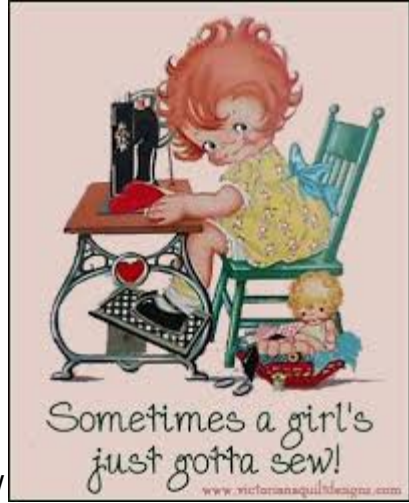
